

Emergency Motion: West Bank Annexation

Seconder: Patrick Sikorski

This AGM declares an international emergency as Israel's February 8th cabinet decisions constitute an unprecedented escalation of colonial land theft and de jure annexation of the West Bank, directly threatening Palestinian existence and self-determination.

The Israeli government has:

- Repealed laws preventing settlers from purchasing land directly from Palestinians
- Abolished oversight mechanisms for real estate transactions, enabling massive corruption
- Opened classified land registries to settlers, enabling mass land confiscation
- Granted Israeli enforcement powers in Areas A and B, violating international agreements
- Removed planning authority from the Hebron Municipality
- Established Israeli administration at Rachel's Tomb in Bethlehem

PSC believes these actions complete the de jure annexation of Areas A, B and C; destroying and marking the end of the Oslo Accords framework and constituting the complete erasure of Palestinian land rights and self-determination. This represents the final stage of colonial dispossession that began with the 1948 Nakba.

Therefore this AGM calls for:

1. Immediate emergency rally outside the Israeli embassy next week to protest these latest colonial aggressions and demand an end to all annexation.
